### **BOMA S.F. HOSTS REVIEW OF PRESIDIO MASTER PLAN**

#### ***Vice Chair of Presidio Trust Board of Directors to Discuss Key Points***

- WHAT:** A luncheon presentation and discussion of the Presidio Master Plan by Mary G. Murphy, Vice-chair of the Presidio Trust Board of Directors. Ms Murphy will review key points of the recently released Master Plan, which serves as the framework for future decisions and outlines the Presidio Trust's "preferred uses" for specific areas of the national park. The Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) of San Francisco will host the event.
- WHY:** According to U.S. Congressional mandate, the Presidio must generate enough revenue to be financially self sufficient by 2013. The Master Plan provides the roadmap by which a blend of private and public ventures will achieve the mandate. Ms. Murphy will provide an overview of the Master Plan, taking into account the numerous variables involved in what has been a high profile and sometimes-polarizing endeavor.
- WHO:** Hosted by the BOMA San Francisco, the guest speaker will be Mary G. Murphy, who was appointed to the Presidio Trust Board by Former President Bill Clinton as Vice-chair of the Presidio Trust Board of Directors; President Bush extended her term. An attorney and partner in the law firm of Farella, Braun + Martel, LLP, Ms. Murphy served from 1993 to 1996 as Vice President of the Board of Permit Appeals for the City and County of San Francisco. She is a former Co-chair of Neighborhood Associations for Presidio Planning, an umbrella organization of San Francisco neighborhood associations surrounding the Presidio. In that position, she testified before Congress regarding the legislation to create the Presidio Trust.
