BOMA SAN FRANCISCO TO HOST SECURITY AND SAFETY FORUM

Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Special Agent to Discuss Threat Assessment and Practical Security Considerations

WHAT: The Building Owners Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) of San Francisco hosts a luncheon forum tomorrow in which high-rise commercial property owners, managers and tenants will be briefed by Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Special Agent Larry Mefford on:

- _ Potential security threats to San Francisco's high-rise buildings and other landmarks;
- _ The various means for detecting potential terrorist activities;
- _ What owners, managers and tenants should do in the event of terrorist action; and
- _ What the federal government is doing to assess and respond to potential threats to San Francisco's high-rise buildings and landmarks.

In addition, Dr. Stephen White, Ph.D., the president and founder of Work Trauma Services, will address the concerns and fears of high-rise office tenants and workers regarding terrorist threats and activities. He also will discuss how attendees and their families can manage their shock, anger and grief over the September 11 terrorist attack on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon.

WHY: Minimizing security risks in San Francisco's high-rise office buildings, as well as other landmarks, is a priority for BOMA SF and local officials.
